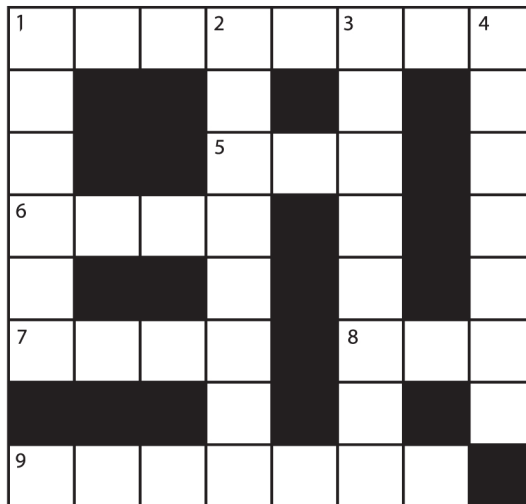
The collapsible version of this device was made popular by Parisian merchant Jean Marius in the early 18th century.
